An evening of Catholic apologetics

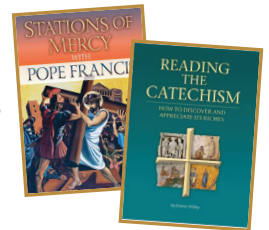
Wednesday, 4 May 2016 (7pm start) at St. Patrick's Church, Soho Square W1D 4NR
